All coaches operating on these services are normally equipped with reclining seats and a toilet/washroom [except connecting services X1 & 900].

Passengers joining services at Belfast and Cairnryan must check-in 30 minutes prior to departure time shown.

Passengers MUST be in possession of separate portions of a multi-stage ticket for each of the following sections of journey as appropriate: Edinburgh or any other point north of Glasgow to/from Glasgow [Citylink or Megabus coach], Glasgow to/from Cairnryan [Citylink or Ulsterbus Coach], Cairnryan to Belfast and if appropriate, Belfast to Dublin [Ulsterbus/Bus Eireann Coach] or Dublin to Londonderry [Ulsterbus Coach] It is important that these instructions are followed to avoid delay and inconvenience to passengers.

Please note that transferral of luggage is the passengers responsibility throughout the journey.
